A BILL

To modify the boundary of the Berryessa Snow Mountain National Monument to include certain Federal land in Lake County, California, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Berryessa Snow Moun-
- 5 tain National Monument Expansion Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 7 In this Act:

1	(1) Walker Ridge (molok luyuk) Addi-
2	TION.—The term "Walker Ridge (Molok Luyuk) Ad-
3	dition" means the approximately 3,925 acres of Fed-
4	eral land administered by the Bureau of Land Man-
5	agement land in Lake County, California, and iden-
6	tified as "Proposed Walker Ridge (Molok Luyuk)
7	Addition" on the Map and all lands and interest in
8	lands therein and objects thereon.
9	(2) Map.—The term "Map" means the map en-
10	titled "Proposed Walker Ridge (Molok Luyuk) Addi-
11	tion Berryessa Snow Mountain National Monument"
12	and dated October 26, 2021.
13	(3) Molok Luyuk.—The term "Molok Luyuk"
14	means Condor Ridge (in the Patwin language).
15	(4) National monument.—The term "Na-
16	tional Monument" means the Berryessa Snow Moun-
17	tain National Monument established by Presidential
18	Proclamation 9298 of July 10, 2015 (80 Fed. Reg.
19	41975 (July 15, 2015)) and all lands and interest
20	in lands therein and all objects thereon identified by
21	such Presidential Proclamation.
22	SEC. 3. NATIONAL MONUMENT EXPANSION.
23	(a) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—The boundary of
24	the National Monument is modified to include the Walker
25	Ridge (Molok Luyuk) Addition.

1	(b) Map.—
2	(1) Corrections.—The Secretary of the Inte-
3	rior may make clerical and typographical corrections
4	to the Map. Such corrections shall have the same
5	force and effect as if the revised Map were included
6	as part of this Act.
7	(2) Public availability.—The Map, and any
8	subsequent revised Map, shall be publicly available
9	on the website of the Bureau of Land Management.
10	(e) Administration.—Subject to valid existing
11	rights, the Secretary of the Interior shall administer the
12	Walker Ridge (Molok Luyuk) Addition—
13	(1) as part of the National Monument;
14	(2) in accordance with Presidential Proclama-
15	tion 9298 of July 10, 2015 (80 Fed. Reg. 41975
16	(July 15, 2015)); and
17	(3) in accordance with applicable laws (includ-
18	ing regulations).
19	SEC. 4. MANAGEMENT PLAN.
20	(a) In General.—Not later than 1 year after the
21	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the
22	Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture shall jointly de-
23	velop a comprehensive management plan for the National
24	Monument in accordance with, and in a manner that ful-
25	fills the purposes specified in, Presidential Proclamation

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1	9298 of July 10, 2015 (80 Fed. Reg. 41975 (July 15,
2	2015)).
3	(b) Tribal Consultation.—The Secretary of the
4	Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture shall consult
5	with affected federally recognized Indian Tribes—
6	(1) in the development of the management plan
7	and
8	(2) to inform subsequent management decisions
9	regarding the National Monument.
10	(c) Continued Engagement With Indian
11	TRIBES.—The management plan shall set forth param-
12	eters for continued meaningful engagement with affected
13	federally recognized Indian Tribes in implementation of
14	the management plan.
15	SEC. 5. AGREEMENTS AND PARTNERSHIPS.
16	(a) In General.—To the greatest extent practicable
17	and in accordance with applicable Federal or State laws
18	the Secretary concerned shall enter into agreements, con-
19	tracts, and other similarly cooperative and collaborative
20	partnerships if requested by an affected federally recog-
21	nized Indian Tribe regarding management of the National
22	Monument pursuant to relevant Federal authority, includ-
23	ing—
24	(1) the Indian Self-Determination and Edu-

cation Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.);

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1	(2) the Federal Land Policy and Management
2	Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.);
3	(3) the Tribal Self-Governance Act of 1994 (25
4	U.S.C. 5361 et seq.);
5	(4) Executive Order 13175 (dated November 6,
6	2000);
7	(5) the Tribal Forest Protection Act of 2004
8	(25 U.S.C. 3115a et seq.);
9	(6) section 8206 (good neighbor authority) of
10	the Agricultural Act of 2014 (16 U.S.C. 2113a);
11	(7) Secretarial Order 3342, dated October 21,
12	2016; or
13	(8) Joint Secretarial Order 3403 (dated No-
14	vember 15, 2021).
15	(b) Definition of Secretary Concerned.—In
16	this section, the term "Secretary concerned" means, as
17	applicable—
18	(1) the Secretary of the Interior, acting through
19	the Director of the Bureau of Land Management; or
20	(2) the Secretary of Agriculture, acting through
21	the Chief of the Forest Service.
22	SEC. 6. RENAMING OF WALKER RIDGE IN LAKE AND
23	COLUSA COUNTIES, CALIFORNIA.
24	(a) In General.—The parcel of Federal land admin-
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1	Lake and Colusa Counties in the State of California and
2	commonly referred to as "Walker Ridge" before the date
3	of the enactment of this Act shall be known and des-
4	ignated as "Condor Ridge (Molok Luyuk)".
5	(b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
6	ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
7	States to the parcel of Federal land described in sub-
8	section (a) shall be deemed to be a reference to "Condor
9	Ridge (Molok Luyuk)".
10	(c) Map and Legal Description.—
11	(1) Preparation.—
12	(A) INITIAL MAP.—The Board on Geo-
13	graphic Names (established by section 2 of the
14	Act of July 25, 1947; 43 U.S.C. 364a) shall
15	prepare a map and legal description of the par-
16	cel of Federal land designated in subsection (a)
17	as Condor Ridge (Molok Luyuk).
18	(B) Corrections.—The Board on Geo-
19	graphic Names and the Director of the Bureau
20	of Land Management may make clerical and ty-
21	pographical corrections to the map and legal de-
22	scription prepared under this subsection.
23	(2) Consultation.—In preparing the map and
24	legal description under paragraph (1)(A), the Board
25	on Geographic Names shall consult with—

1	(A) the Director of the Bureau of Land
2	Management; and
3	(B) affected federally recognized Indian
4	Tribes.
5	(3) Public availability.—The map and legal
6	description and any subsequent revised map or legal
7	description prepared pursuant to paragraph (1) shall
8	be publicly available on the website of the Board on
9	Geographic Names, the Bureau of Land Manage-
10	ment, or both.
11	(4) Legal effect.—The map and legal de-
12	scription, and any subsequent revised map or legal
13	description prepared pursuant to paragraph (1) shall
14	have the same force and effect as if included in this
15	Act.
