 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Airports, Highways,
5 High-Speed Rail, Trains, and Transit: Make it in America
6 Act".

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1 SEC. 2. AIRPORTS.

2	Section 50101(b) of title 49, United States Code, is
3	amended—
4	(1) by striking paragraphs (1) and (2);
5	(2) by redesignating paragraphs (3) and (4) as
6	paragraphs (1) and (2) , respectively; and
7	(3) in paragraph (1) (as so redesignated) by
8	striking subparagraph (A) and inserting the fol-
9	lowing:
10	"(A) the cost of components and sub-
11	components produced in the United States is—
12	"(i) more than 60 percent of the cost
13	of all components of the facility or equip-
14	ment, in the case of obligations made on or
15	before December 31, 2011;
16	"(ii) more than 80 percent of the cost
17	of all components of the facility or equip-
18	ment, in the case of obligations made in
19	the period beginning January 1, 2012, and
20	ending December 31, 2012; or
21	"(iii) 100 percent of the cost of all
22	components of the facility or equipment, in
23	the case of obligations made after Decem-
24	ber 31, 2013; and".

1 SEC. 3. HIGHWAYS AND ROADWAYS.

2 Section 313(b) of title 23, United States Code, is3 amended to read as follows:

4 "(b) The Secretary may waive subsection (a) if the
5 Secretary finds that including domestic material will in6 crease the cost of the overall project by more than 25 per7 cent.".

8 SEC. 4. HIGH SPEED RAIL.

9 Section 24405(a)(2) of title 49, United States Code,
10 is amended to read as follows:

"(2) The Secretary may waive paragraph (1) if the
Secretary finds that including domestic material will increase the cost of the overall project by more than 25 percent.".

15 SEC. 5. AMTRAK TRAINS.

16 Section 24305(f) of title 49, United States Code, is17 amended by striking paragraph (4).

18 SEC. 6. BUSES, LIGHT RAIL, HEAVY RAIL.

19 Section 5323(j)(2) of title 49, United States Code,
20 is amended—

- 21 (1) by striking subparagraphs (A) and (B);
- (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (C) and(D) as subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively; and
- 24 (3) by striking subparagraph (A)(i) (as so re-25 designated) and inserting the following:

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1	"(i) the cost of components and sub-
2	components produced in the United States

4	"(I) more than 60 percent of the

6	stock, in the case of obligations made
