MOTION TO RECOMMIT, WITH INSTRUCTIONS

Mr. Garamendi moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 351, to the Committee on Energy and Commerce with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, insert the following new section:

SEC. 4. PROTECTING OUR NATIONAL SECURITY AND CRE-2 ATING AMERICAN JOBS. 3 In reviewing an application for authorization to export natural gas under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act 4 5 (15 U.S.C. 717b), the Department of Energy— 6 (1) shall deny such application if the natural 7 gas would be exported to any nation that is a state 8 sponsor of terrorism or otherwise threatens Amer-9 ica's national security, or to any nation or corpora-10 tion that steals America's military technology or in-11 tellectual property through cyber-attacks; and 12 (2) shall require, as a condition for approval of 13 any such authorization, the applicant to ensure that 14 United States-flagged and built ships and shipping
