A BILL

To limit the retirement of KC-10 aircraft.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON RETIREMENT OF KC-10 AIR-4 CRAFT.

5 (a) LIMITATION.—None of the funds authorized to 6 be appropriated or otherwise made available for the De-7 partment of Defense may be obligated or expended to re-8 tire, prepare to retire, or place in storage any KC–10 air-9 craft until each of the following occurs: 2

1	(1) The Secretary of the Air Force certifies to
2	the congressional defense committees each of the fol-
3	lowing:
4	(A) The four KC-46A test aircraft are all
5	built and fully operational including their air
6	refueling capability.
7	(B) The initial 18 KC-46A aircraft have
8	been delivered to the Air Force in a fully oper-
9	ational capacity by 2017.
10	(C) The KC–46A aircraft has achieved full
11	operational capability.
12	(D) A sufficient number of KC-46A air-
13	craft exists in the inventory of the Air Force to
14	fully meet the air refueling and cargo support
15	capability and mission requirements of the com-
16	batant commands.
17	(2) The Comptroller General of the United
18	States submits to the congressional defense commit-
19	tees a report setting forth the following:
20	(A) An assessment whether each certifi-
21	cation under paragraph (1) is comprehensive,
22	fully supported, and sufficiently detailed.
23	(B) An identification of any shortcomings,
24	limitations, or other reportable matters that af-

fect the quality or findings of any certification
under paragraph (1).

3 (b) DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF COMPTROLLER 4 GENERAL REPORT.—The report of the Comptroller Gen-5 eral under paragraph (2) of subsection (a) shall be sub-6 mitted not later than 90 days after the date of the submis-7 sion of the certification referred to in paragraph (1) of 8 such subsection.

9 (c) CONGRESSIONAL DEFENSE COMMITTEES DE-10 FINED.—In this section, the term "congressional defense 11 committees" has the meaning given that term in section 12 101(a)(16) of title 10, United States Code.
