RE: Markeley Lane Extension

Dear Chairmen Cole and Womack and Ranking Members DeLauro and Quigley:

I respectfully request \$5,000,000 for the Markeley Lane Extension Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Fairfield located at 1000 Webster Street, Fairfield, CA 94533.

This community project funding would be used to extend Markeley Lane approximately a quarter mile from Viking Lane to Peabody Road, which is a key arterial roadway connecting the Cities of Fairfield and Vacaville and providing critical access to Travis Air Force Base. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will allow approximately 2,950 students and their guardians served by the Travis Unified School District to access four public schools more easily: Center Elementary, Golden West Middle School, Travis Education Center, and Vanden High School. Military-connected students account for 24.06 percent of students attending these four schools. The project has a federal nexus because the funding requested is for purposes authorized by sections 133(b)(1) and 201 of title 23, United States Code.

Pursuant to Clause 17 of Rule XXIII of the U.S. House of Representatives, I certify that I have no financial interest in this project and neither does anyone in my immediate family. Thank you for your leadership and consideration of my request.
