- **Face masks or coverings, two per person***
- **Sanitation supplies such as disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer**
- **Map marked with two evacuation routes**
- **Medication, supplies and medical devices**
- **An extra set of keys**
- **Eyeglasses or contact lenses**
- **A change of clothes**
- **Cash in small bills**
- **First-aid kit**
- **Flashlight**
- **Charging cables for your cellphone and a portable battery pack**
- **A portable radio and batteries**
- **Baby and pet supplies**
- **Your ID and your important documents**
- **Water: One gallon a person, per day**
- **Food: nonperishable, easy-to-prepare items**
- **Easily carried valuables**
- **Personal computer info on hard drives and disks**
